Through UW Libraries, faculty, staff, and students can activate digital access to publications such as The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, Financial Times, The Atlantic, The Economist, and many more. This is a valuable benefit available to the entire UW community.

Getting started is easy:

1. Visit the UW Libraries E-Newspapers page.
2. Select the publication you'd like to read.
3. Follow the activation instructions and sign in with your UW NetID when prompted.
4. Enjoy full digital access from your computer, tablet, or mobile device (availability varies by publication).
